 - Volunteer Incentive Program! First 100 volunteers to sign up for an activity receive a free POM t-shirt. Also ordered 24 extra for sizes we needed after we placed initial order. Ended up with enough shirts to include Air Show volunteers (including student volunteers). Priced at \$11/shirt (with \$2 extra for 2X and \$3 extra for 3X), the shirts are made of waterproof, quick dry and came out great. Awaiting the arrival of the additional 24 shirts and 6 shirts for the "Grill Masters"
