Executive Board Reports

Treasurer Report Mr. Lakota presented the financial reports (see attached) outlining the \$650 expense for After Prom donation, \$100 to Giant Eagle for Academic Boosters reverse raffle & \$24 deposit for uniform cleaning. Carter Lanmack received the highest award for a high school performer at the All-State Orchestra earlier this month. Band festivals letters have been mailed & emailed inviting other bands to perform. Details regarding the Hawaii trip were discussed. 119 band members with a total of 277 traveling. Band Festival RSVPs will probably not start firming up until June/July. Uniforms should arrive in April. Plumes are already in! Thoughts about involving the high school's construction trades in maximizing our storage space for new uniforms.
