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Attention Percussionists and Parents,

Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>

In preparing for next year's Pride of Mayfield Marching Band season, we will be holding drumline auditions in a few weeks. These auditions will enable us to determine the best suited instrument for each student to play. The four instruments available for audition are: snare drum, bass drum, quints, and cymbals.

Audition days are posted below and signup sheets will be posted in the band rooms. All current students wanting to participate must audition on either Wednesday, May 11th or Thursday, May 12th. A signup will be posted for you to commit to an audition time.

Attached are the audition materials and a sample of the scoring sheet. Everyone must prepare rudiments from the rudiment pages. We will select 2-3 <u>Rudiments</u> at random for you to play. No matter on which instrument(s) you'd like to audition, EVERYONE WILL PLAY RUDIMENTS. Next, you will play the <u>Prepared Individual Song Excerpt</u> for the instrument(s) on which you'd like to audition. Lastly, you will do a Sight Reading for the instrument(s) on which you'd like to audition.

You may audition for up to two instruments. Those interested in playing bass drum or cymbals should pay close attention to parts. Both instruments have "split" parts in the Prepared Individual Song Excerpts and Sight-Reading, meaning that each space of the staff represents when one person plays from the squad is to play. Remember that the middle *line* means that everyone in the squad plays. Please prepare music for each individual space. If auditioning for Snare drum or Quints, practice with heavy sticks on a bouncy surface, as you will be auditioning on the real marching equipment. Bass drum parts will be played on a marching bass drum. Cymbal parts will be played with marching cymbals.

PLEASE FEEL FREE to contact Mr. Treiber or Mr. Fancher as there may be general things on these auditions that you may have questions about. However, to be fair, we cannot help you with specific answers on how to play, count, or stick something.

#### **<u>Audition requirements:</u>**

- 1 Rudiments (2-3 will be selected at your audition)
- 2 Prepared Individual Song Excerpt(s)
- 3 Sight Reading

#### Audition Dates (sign up sheets available soon in band room)

Wednesday May 11<sup>th</sup>: 3:30pm-6:30pm in HS Band Room.

Thursday May 12th: 3:30pm-6:30pm in HS Band Room.

When signing up for auditions, please sign up for 10 minutes (for one instrument). If you're auditioning for more than one instrument, sign up for an additional adjacent 10 minute slot.






